The Organised Spider

Always be careful around spiders. Remember spiders can bite. These bites can be very painful and some spider bites are deadly, so if you see a spider, move away and tell a grown-up!

It is easy to tell the difference between an insect and a spider. Insects have six legs, but spiders have eight legs. Many spiders have silk glands in their abdomens, which they use to create their webs. Spiders use their webs to catch their prey. They are very organised!

Most spiders have fangs which they use to bite and inject venom. This is why you need to keep away from spiders!!

There are over 30,000 species of spiders in the world. Most spiders have six or eight eyes. Spiders spend most of their life hunting for food.

The spider is another sensational creature God has created – but it is a creature we need to watch from a distance. You don't want to get bitten! So remember everyone keep away from spiders!!

Moving Water Experiment

You will need (*A grown-up to supervise because there is hot water involved!*)

- 1 jar of hot water
- 1 jar of cold of water
- red and blue food dye
- piece of cardboard wide enough to cover top of jar

Method

- Put a few drops of red food dye into the hot water.
- Put a few drops of blue food dye into the cold water.
- Place piece of cardboard over mouth of jar containing cold water.
- Quickly and carefully flip the cold water jar upside-down and place on top of the hot water jar.
- Pull the slip of cardboard out and watch what happens to the water.

Analysis

1. What difficulties if any did you have with this experiment?

2. What was the reason the water stayed in the cold water jar when it was flipped upside down with only a piece of cardboard sitting on it?

3. Why did the two colours mix together when the slip of cardboard was pulled out?

4. What can we learn about organisation from this experiment?

You will need

4 black hairy pipe cleaners
½ a small black pipe cleaner
2 large black pom poms
2 small red pom poms
2 eyes
red felt for mouth
glue



What you do



1. Find the middle of the four large pipe cleaners and wrap the small pipe cleaner around the centre of the 4 larger pipe cleaners to join them together.



2. Bend the large pipe cleaners to shape 8 legs and 8 feet.



3. Glue on the two large black pom poms to make the body.




4. Glue the red pom poms to the top of the smaller pipe cleaners to make the antennae.

5. Glue on the eyes and the felt for the mouth.
